

## How to send information about boundary mark

### NAME

*A name of the boundary mark; e.g. name is used from people living near the position of the boundary mark*

1. A photo of the boundary stone, preferably with GNSS coordinates (WGS84; EPSG Code 4326) → .jpg file medium resolution.  
Switch on the position service of your smartphone
2. Additional photos of all sides of the boundary stone and of the surrounding area would also be helpful.
3. A short description of the boundary stone e.g. the height, the material and any visible letters, numbers or other inscriptions/marks and some historical information about the border or the boundary stone.
4. The year of installation of the boundary stone.
5. If it is not possible to give GNSS coordinates, then give some other information about the position e.g. the address (house name/number, street name, village, town or city) or a scanned map with the point marked on the map, or a URL linking to a point on an existing Web GIS map.
6. The name of the person who took the photo (for copyright).
7. The name of the person who wrote the historical information.
